## **Warringah Amateur Swimming Association Rules**

### **1 COMPETITION**

- 1.01 The Association may conduct Championships, Scratch, Handicap and Team Relay Events as well as other Meets as may be approved by a simple majority at a General Meeting.
- 1.02 All clubs affiliated with W.A.S.A. are obliged to swim in their own District Championship Meet, ahead of outside meets. Failure to do this may disqualify the Club from the next District Championship.
- 1.03 Dates and venue for all W.A.S.A. Carnivals for the ensuing season shall be recommended by the Race and Carnival Committee and considered at the two General Meetings prior to the Annual General Meeting. Following approval of the dates, venue and program at the General Meeting immediately prior to the Annual General Meeting, the Race Secretary will report same at the Annual General Meeting.
- 1.04 Details of events, point score and general conditions shall be set out in the attached General Rules, which can be altered by a simple majority of representatives, present at a General Meeting provided that a recession motion to alter any rule cannot be proposed for 6 months except by the Race and Carnival committee who must submit a written motion of alteration.
- 1.05 The entry fee for any W.A.S.A. Teams in events conducted by the S.N.S.W. shall be paid by the Association.

### **2 CARNIVALS and MEETS**

- 2.01 With the exception of a recommendation in the form of a written motion by the Race and Carnival Committee, no rescission motion shall be accepted against any specific rule change, particularly those relating to the Premier Point Score, Championships, Scratch and Handicap Carnivals, trophies, etc., until six (6) months have elapsed from the date of the said rule change.
- 2.02 The Rules relating to the conduct of the Premier Point Score, Championships, Scratch and Handicap Carnivals shall not be amended unless Notice of Motion, in writing, has been given to the Secretaries at or before the Meeting prior to the Meeting, at which the amendment is to be discussed. An amendment shall be carried by a simple majority of those present and voting at the Meeting.
