



Application for Dick Gallie Memorial Scholarship

Awarded annually to a deserving swimmer in memory of Dick's contribution to the Warringah Amateur Swimming Association and School Swimming NSW



Each club may nominate one (1) swimmer. The club must have been affiliated with Swimming NSW and WASA on 1st January 2010. The swimmer nominated must be registered with Swimming NSW and attain the age of ten (10) years in the period 1st July 2009 to 30th June 2010.

Each section of the form must be completed. If any section is deemed not applicable for the applicant, enter the words 'not applicable'. Applications must be sent to:

The Secretary, WASA, PO Box 6247, FRENCHS FOREST NSW, 2086 by 21st May 2010. Late applications will not be considered.

The final selection will be made by the WASA Selection Committee. No correspondence on the Award will be entered into.

The winner of the Award will be announced at the June meeting of the Association.

Applications will only be accepted from clubs affiliated with Warringah Amateur Swimming Association on 1st January 2010. This requirement may terminate at a date to be determined by the Committee.

The scholarship will consist of a \$300 grant, to assist with the swimmer's coaching fees. A package of swimming products, donated by Schools Swimming, will also be awarded to the swimmer.
