Designed to encourage swimmers who have proven their commitment to the sport of swimming, these scholarships do not necessarily recognise the fastest swimmers, but those who are bettering themselves and contributing to their clubs in a meaningful way.

In 2019, we are offering the following Swimming Scholarships, detailed below:

- The Dick Gallie Memorial Scholarship
- Up to four Warringah Amateur Swimming Association Winter Training Scholarships
- Five Northern Beaches Council Awards comprising Entry Passes to the Warringah Aquatic Centre to be issued in conjunction with training with Big Blue

Swimmers nominated should have demonstrated a good all-round attitude, as well as swimming skill, which will benefit them from being a successful WASA scholar.

A swimmer may be nominated for one, two or three scholarships, **but may only win one scholarship** in any year. All nominations received from member clubs will be carefully considered by the Selection Committee, with the winners announced at the Association's Annual General Meeting on 6 May 2019.
