CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Age: as at the day of the meet.

Registration: all competitors must be registered members of an affiliated club.

Entry fees: \$5 per individual event and \$10 per relay event. Pool entry fees also apply.

Events: will be conducted as timed finals.

Point score: points will be awarded but not where a swimmer is disqualified or, when applicable, does not achieve the qualifying time.

Qualifying times: where an event has a qualifying time, entrants must have recorded a faster time than the qualifying time to enter the event.

Relays: clubs may enter a maximum of two relay teams per event, by submitting a Relay Entry Form to the Recording Desk prior to Event 15 for Events 23 and 24 and prior to Event 38 for Events 53, 54 and 55.

All relay events are mixed gender events and must comprise at least one male and one female swimmer.

Rules: the meet shall be conducted under the Rules of the Association.

Dash for Cash events: the fastest eight swimmers from Events 7, 8, 9 and 10 will be selected to compete in these events, with cash prizes awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters.

Medals and ribbons: medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters in each age group and ribbons will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getting teams in relay events.

Records: record breakers shall be awarded an official Record Certificate.

Closing date: Club Race Secretaries must submit their members' entries through WASA's Online Entry System by 9:00 pm on Wednesday 3 December 2025. Late entries **will not** be accepted and members should be aware that individual clubs may choose to set a closing date that is earlier than the closing date set by WASA.
